2009 Homeboys Golf Invitational Tourney Info and Format

THE FORMAT: This is an **INDIVIDUAL TOURNAMENT**. At the Thursday night's Grand Pupa Party there will be a blind draw for partners, divided between "A players" and "B Players" and for tee-times. The Tournament is over 54 holes in 3 days and fully handicapped. How does it work? You take your team score from your first day and add it to your team score from your second day and this becomes your total combined two day individual score going into your final round. The lowest-accumulated individual score for 3 days will be crowned the Grand Pupa.

Day 1: Four man scramble (Add all handicaps and divide by 4)

Day 2: Two man best ball (100% of handicap)

Day 3: Individual medal play, add them all up. (100% of handicap) –A maximum of score of 10 on any one hole including par 5's and par 3's)

Tee Times and Courses:

Check in at the pro shop no later than 7:15 a.m. Friday morning. Tee times on Saturday and Sunday are based on the drawing of partners. Tee times will be posted at the hospitality suite

Entry Fee:

Fees are as follows:

Prior to June 1, 2009 \$350

After June 1, 2009 \$450

Sponsorship: Sponsor \$100 (*encouraged*)

The Rules:

USGA rules apply. In case of a tie there will be sudden death play off. Putt them all out.

The Field:

52 players

Afternoon Rounds:

Make your own games and based on tee time availability. Saturday – North/South Competition. Tampa vs. Jacksonville.

Room Check-in:

Check in your luggage at the bell stand at the Villas of Grand Cypress when you arrive. The Bellman will deliver your luggage to your room while you are golfing. There will be 8 players to a villa and 2 players to a room.

Scorecards:

Please turn in your score card at the hospitality suite or to a staff member after your round. Remember to sign and date your card.

The Stakes: Awards and Payouts*

The Tournament Stakes: \$9,600 (if 64 players) in cash and the chance to be crowned the 2009 Grand Pupa, and possession of the Grand Pupa Trophy for one year. The \$150 tournament entry fee is covered in your \$350 entry fee.

TOURNAMENT PAYOUT:

Day 1: 20% of the total purse will be paid to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place TEAM (4 man scramble)

1st: 55% = \$1056

2nd: 28% = \$537

3rd: 17% = \$327

Day 2: 20% of the total purse will be paid to the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th place TEAMS.

1st: 30% = \$576

2nd: 25% = \$480

3rd: 20% = \$384

4th: 15% = \$288

5th: 10% = \$192

Day 3: 20% of the total purse will be paid to the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th place INDIVIDUAL

1st: 19% = \$365

2nd: 17% = \$326

3rd: 15% = \$288

4th: 13% = \$250

5th: 12% = \$230

6th: 10% = \$192

7th: 8% = \$153

8th: 6% = \$116

Overall Tournament: 40% of the purse will be paid to 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th place INDIVIDUAL (3 day total)

1st: 19% = \$730

2nd: 17% = \$652

3rd: 15% = \$576

4th: 13% = \$500

5th: 12% = \$460

6th: 10% = \$384

7th: 8% = \$306

8th: 6% = \$232

HOMEBOY 201 CLUB: "Optional and Encouraged"

\$50 Entry Fee - Those players who have a total accumulated individual score after 3 rounds of 201 or less will share equally in the total pot.

For Example: 40 players enter at \$50.00 equals \$2,000 minus 10% for "Random Acts of Kindness."

Total Pool \$1,800.00 and (6) players score 201 or better, each share is worth \$300.00 a player.

CALCUTTA:

Each Player has the right to buy themselves before the auction for \$200.00

If you do not purchase yourself, your name will be placed in the auction for everyone to buy. Opening bid of \$50.00 and increments of \$25.00 per bid, until sold (NO LIMIT)

**final numbers based on total participants*

Payouts will be as follows:

Total pool minus 10% for "Random Acts of Kindness."

Example → 50 players purchase themselves for \$200.00 and other 14 players average \$150.00 each for a pool of \$12,100.00 minus 10% for "Random Acts of Kindness."
Total pool \$10,9000.00.

20% of total pool will be paid out on Fridays round, 20% paid out on Saturdays round, and 20% paid out on Sundays round, leaving 40% to be paid out for the top (8) places overall winners.

- 2nd place will pay 30% or \$654.00 per team
- 3rd place will pay 20% or \$436.00 per team
- 4th place will pay 10% or \$218.00 per team

- 2nd place will pay 24% or \$523.00
- 3rd place will pay 19% or \$414.00
- 4th place will pay 15% or \$327.00
- 5th place will pay 9% or \$196.00
- 6th place will pay 5% or \$110.00

Sunday's Individual Round

- 1st place will pay 19% or \$415.00
- 2nd place will pay 17% or \$370.00
- 3rd place will pay 15% or \$328.00
- 4th place will pay 13% or \$285.00
- 5th place will pay 12% or \$260.00
- 6th place will pay 10% or \$218.00
- 7th place will pay 8% or \$174.00
- 8th place will pay 6% or \$130.00

Overall Finishers

- 1st place will pay 19% or \$830.00
- 2nd place will pay 17% or \$740.00
- 3rd place will pay 15% or \$656.00
